Looking back over 2021, we were pleased to deliver a second round of Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) advances to our business and farm customers this past spring originating over 3,100 new loans that totaled nearly \$55 million. In August, our Ag loan department hosted Roach Ag Marketing seminars to assist our ag customers with cash grain sales decisions and marketing plans. In September, we introduced our updated logo and proudly celebrated the one year anniversary of our "UNITED TOGETHER Makes the Difference" Cause Day campaign. This employee effort, with bank match, has reached over \$60,000 in donations to causes in the UBI market area. October brought a ribbon cutting at our Alta office drive-up as well as a 25th anniversary celebration at our Charter Oak office.

Looking ahead to 2022, plans are in process to offer instant issue debit cards, as well as making mobile payment technologies like Apple Pay, Google Pay, and Samsung Pay compatible with UBI debit cards. Watch for more information as we hope to introduce these new products in the first quarter. In addition, we will begin construction of our new Marcus facility in the spring.
